- 6. What does Daniel's prayer say about who he believed God to be?
- 7. Who gets the credit for knowing the dream and interpreting it?
- 8. How does Daniel respond to receiving the knowledge of the dream and its interpretation?
- 9. Put the meaning of the dream into your own words.
- 10. Whose kingdom does the dream refer to according to vs. 44-45?
- 11. What does Nebuchadnezzar's response to the interpretation Daniel shared say about him?
- 12. In your opinion is Daniel's reward and promotion merited? If so, why? If not, why not?
- 13. How does this passage challenge or encourage you?
