4. Read Matthew 20:20-28. What do James and John, the sons of Zebedee want?
5. Do they desire a good thing or bad thing?
6. What does Jesus say is the better thing?
7. According to vs. 28, what is Jesus' mission?
8. How does Jesus serve us and how does that inform how we are to serve?
9. Who is the greatest in the Kingdom of God?
10. What are your spiritual gifts? (for gift lists see: 1 Corinthians 12:7-11, 27-30; 13:1-3; Romans 12:4-8; Ephesians 4:11-16; 1 Peter 4:7-11)
11. What is the purpose of spiritual gifts?
12. What are the consequences of not using our gifts to serve one another?
13. How is God calling you to serve your brothers and sisters in Christ?
