- 6. How could a husband overcome a harsh (embittered/resentful) attitude towards his wife?
- 7. Compare vs. 20 with Exodus 20:12. What's the difference between honoring your parents and obeying them?
- 8. How does vs. 3:22-4:1 change the way people would look at slavery?
- 9. What is the motive for a slave to obey their master?
- 10. What is the difference between masters treating their slaves with kindness vs. "right and fair"?
- 11. Who do both slave and master have to answer to?
- 12. How does reverence for the Lord affect your work ethic?
- 13. How does this passage challenge or encourage you?
