7. How does understanding God’s judgment affect your perseverance in “doing good”?
8. What does it look like for a believer to approach the end of all things according to this passage?
9. How do the actions listed in vs. 7-9 help us in the last days?
10. How does love cover a multitude of sins?
11. What spiritual gifts has God given you? How do you know?
12. What does it mean to be a faithful steward of the spiritual gifts God has given?
13. How does this passage challenge or encourage you?
