- 7. According to Luke 19, what didn't the Pharisees understand?
- 8. If a king were coming to his kingdom, what would you expect that he do first?
- 9. How does what Jesus did in Luke 19:45-48 challenge or confirm those expectations?
- 10. What does it say about Jesus' kingdom priorities?
- 11. Why would Jesus turning over tables in the temple upset the religious leaders?
- 12. How did the crowds respond to Jesus' actions and teachings?
- 13. How does this passage challenge or encourage you to worship Jesus?
